

Private sale – rubber bumpered MGBGT V8 in a rare colour Chartreuse



Chartreuse 2839 is a Factory MGBGT V8 with original bodywork and black trim. It was despatched from the MG Factory to the main dealer, Newbury Motors at Halesowen, on 9th April 1976 and was kept there as their “showroom car” and was the last Factory made MGBGT V8 to be first registered on 7th October 1977. It has the registration SOX 417 S. The PDI was carried out the same day and subsequent servicing can be seen in the “Service Book” kept with the car. Servicing was carried out for many years by the late Geoff Allen until 1994 and thereafter by a well respected independent firm of Motor engineers in Buckinghamshire. Rare colour, only **19** V8s produced in Chartreuse. **Reduced to £14,250 ovno.**
