



Private sale - rare MG RV8 GT in Dodge Viper Blue

This much admired, well known and very rare car, finished in Dodge Viper Blue, was built with great care using a fully restored 1972 BGT shell and a 1995 RV8 donor car and completed in 2000. It has featured in MG World and MG Enthusiast magazines. I bought it in 2011 and am the second owner. Mileage is now 45,000 miles. Comprehensive history file including the build. It was registered as a 1972 MG V8 so is road tax exempt and has an MoT until 13th July 2025. It has been carefully maintained, always garaged and is in excellent condition. The 3.9 litre RV8 engine has a fast roadcam and chipped ECU and produces about 208 bhp on the rolling road and has an R380 gearbox. Interior is leather and Burr elm from the RV8. Longlife stainless steel cat-free exhaust and tubular manifolds, EZ electric power steering, Spax Krypton dampers, Polybush rear suspension, four new Avon ZV7 tyres on 16" Compomotive wheels and a space saver spare, high torque starter motor, Moto-Lita leather steering wheel, Kenwood radio/CD player, and two keys. **£27,000**
