

Using the Club's online shop to buy an MGB50 Blenheim ticket

As not all members are young internet users familiar with the common procedures with online shops, this note aims to highlight how to order a ticket online.

Finding the Club's online shop

You can use the link on our recent NEWS webpage on the V8 website with an update on this event. It's at:

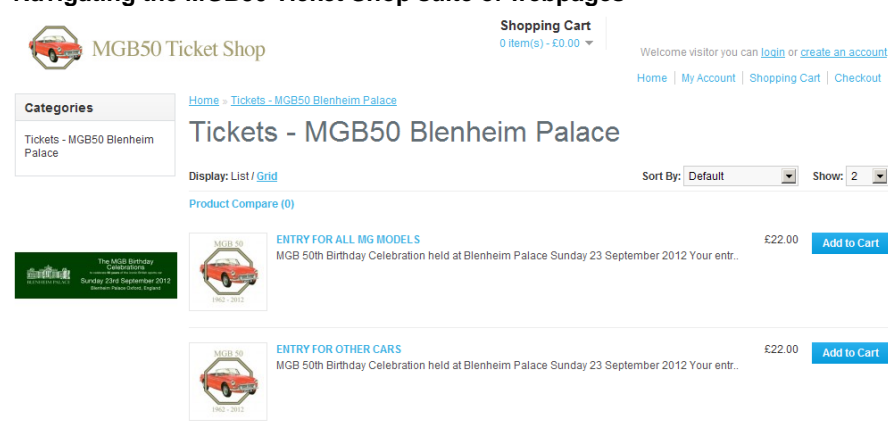
Navigating the mgb50.com website

Scroll to the bottom of the webpage where you will find **See the Tickets page HERE** for details.

Clicking that link takes you to a webpage headed **Booking Tickets for Blenheim Palace** – the link for that webpage is: <http://www.mgb50.com/MGB50/Tickets.html>

Again scroll to the bottom of that webpage where you will find a section **Online Ticket Sales** with a **HERE** link. That link takes you to the **MGB50 Ticket Shop** at:

Now before proceeding further with this online store you need to be aware that when they have a **“Cart” facility and a cookie is used** to help the online sales process. So you need to check what your **cookie blocker settings** are in your

web browser. See an explanation of **how to adjust your cookie blocker settings** at the end of this note. Assuming your cookie blocker settings are at a reduced level you can then proceed with your ticket purchase.

Click the light blue **Add to Cart** button when you will move on to the **Entry for all MG Models** webpage at:

http://www.mgb50shop.com/index.php?route=product/product&product_id=50

Now you need to scroll down the webpage again and fill in the details about you and your car. After completing the data boxes you will see at the foot of the webpage a light blue **Add to Cart** button.

Clicking that Add to Cart button returns you to the top of the webpage where you should see under the heading **Shopping Cart** details of the number of tickets you have purchased. NOTE: if there are no details of a purchase there it is likely your cookie blocker settings are too high and the necessary purchase information has not been carried over to the Shopping Cart. If you have this difficulty then see our note below on reducing your cookie blocker settings.

You now need to checkout

Click the light blue **Checkout** button on the top RH corner of the webpage. Then proceed on the Sage webpage to provide your personal details and card details necessary to complete the purchase.

Confirmation of your purchase

Following the completion of your online ticket purchase you will get an automated email from the MGB50 Shop confirming your purchase and giving you a transaction number plus the Club Office contacts in case of need.

How do I adjust my cookie blocker settings?

In Internet Explorer the routine is:

Click **Tools** then **Internet Options**.

Click **Privacy** when you will see a vertical slider.

Move that slider down to the one up from the bottom setting headed **Low**.

Click **Apply** and then **OK**.

You can then proceed with your online purchase.

Remember when you have completed the online transaction, **if you want to restore a higher level of cookie blocking** then repeat this routine and move the slider up to say the **High** or the **Block all Cookies** setting.
