Two events this Autumn have raised the profile of RV8s in Yorkshire and have left their owners wanting more. First up, on 28th September, was the 'Cars in the Park' event at Lotherton Hall, near Leeds. Dennis Hodge is the coordinator for RV8s at this event and he reports that this has become a regular venue for meetings of RV8 owners in Yorkshire. The tour, organised by Stuart Mumby, took in the stunning scenery of remote **Coverdale** (top right) on the way to a lunch halt at the historic **Falcon Inn** at Arncliffe (above right). The afternoon section progressed through the market town of Settle and on via Burnsall, Pateley Bridge and Nidderdale to the final destination of Masham. Here, the participants tucked in to hearty fayre at the King's Head Hotel overlooking the ancient Market Place. All of the crews declared the day a resounding success and made it clear that they wanted more. To this end, the next tour will be in the Spring of 2015 and will take place in the North York Moors National Park.
