

MGC Weekend at Shelsley Walsh Hill Climb 19th & 20th July 2014

Saturdays entertainment is, spectating at one of the rounds of the MG Luffield Championship and Sunday, Classic Nostalgia throughout the day. We have also included a lovely Country House Hotel nearby for those of you that would like to join us Saturday night, for a Black Tie Dinner, with accommodation, making it a full on spectatar weekend. We have drawn up a number of different packages, however we strongly recommend you sign up for the full weekend, so as not to miss out on anything. All our normal activities will be going on throughout the weekend, plus a short Road Run Sunday morning, back to Shelsley for our second day of Hill Climb excitement. All MG's will be very welcome.

Saturday The day will start from 9.15am at Shelsley Walsh, Worcestershire WR6 6RP. Your committee will be directing you to your display MGC Register Parking Area throughout the morning and advising on the best viewing points and all other activities going on throughout the day. Watch the cars ascend the famous Shelsley Walsh Hill Climb, admire the cars in the paddock, meet the drivers and enjoy some great food in the courtyard, various food outlets available (it is only food that is not included in your ticket price). Last race/climb of the day, should be done for around 5.30pm.

Saturday Evening On arrival at Stone Manor Hotel, you will be directed to our MGC Register Display Parking area. Once you have all checked into the Hotel and had a quick drink in the Bar, it will be time to freshen up and put on your posh frocks in readiness for a delightful evening in the Patio Suite of Stone Manor. We have private dining in a beautiful function room with its own garden. Should the weather be not so accommodating, we also have the option of a private Bar before Dinner. Our menu will be three courses + coffee & mints and I will be sending out menus prior to the event. Due to the lovely surrounding we will be in, I thought this would be the perfect opportunity to suggest we go to town with our dress and opt for Black Tie and Cocktail Dresses, optional of course...

Sunday Once breakfast is all done and dusted, you will be set off for the short Road Run back to Shelsley, for another, very different day at the Hill Climb. Information & Directions for Shelsley Walsh....

From the North...Exit M5 at Jct 6 taking the A449 towards Kidderminster, then take the A4133 to Holt Heath. At Great Witley take the A443, turning left on to the A4203 to Stanford Bridge. As you cross the bridge take the next left to Shelsley Walsh, following the lane until you reach the main entrance.

From the South...Exit M5 at Jct 7 and take the A4440 Worcester Bypass following the signs A44 Bromyard / Leominster. Turn right at the B4197 for Martley going through the village on the B4204 to Clifton / Tenbury. After crossing Ham Bridge turn right for the Shelsleys and follow the lane until you reach the main entrance.

On Arrival...You will be directed to MGC Register Display Parking to enjoy, what we hope to be a fantastic weekend of Motoring at the Oldest Racing Track in the World.

Information & Directions for Stone Manor...

Stone Manor Hotel, Stone, Nr Kidderminster, Worcestershire DY10 4PJ

From the North...Exit M5 at Jct 3 taking the A456 Halesowen until A450 Worcester Road. Then take the A448 Bromsgrove Road. Follow the road until you see signs for Stone Manor on your left.

From the South...Exit M5 at Jct 6 and take the Kidderminster Road A449 until A450 Turn right on to Worcester Road follow A450 until A448 on to Bromsgrove Road Stone Manor will be on your left.
