We are the youngest Centre in the UK having been formed in 1992 with an emphasis on the social side of MG motoring. We now represent the whole of Scotland and have events in virtually every month of the year catering for all types of owner with dinners, visits, shows, motor sport events, one day runs, two day runs and our now flagship events of 3 and 5 Day Tours.

# WHAT EXPERIENCE DO WE HAVE?

Since 1992 we have been running 2/3-day Tours covering all areas of Scotland over the first weekend in May. These tours involve 70 cars and 140 people with pre-arranged accommodation, entertainment & tulip style route books. Our 2009/10 Tours were both fully booked within five days. Such is our reputation!

Since 2009 we have also run 5 Day Tours last year in the north of Scotland and this year on the west coast. These events have attracted participants from all over the UK, Holland, Belgium & even America and Canada.

# WHAT DO WE HAVE TO OFFER?

A Five Day, Four Night event based in Aviemore in the Cairngorms in the Highlands of Scotland. The population of the Highlands is 217k in an area the size of Belgium. Eight people per sq. km. Interesting uncrowded roads! An area of outstanding beauty, home to four of Scotland's highest mountains and 25% of Europe's protected bird, wildlife and plant life.


