

## ETHANOL FUELS PUMP PROBLEMS

Modern fuels, made from or including plant extracts, coffee beans and Himalayan yak droppings, are all very well for modern cars, but life's not so simple for us. In particular, petrol containing ethanol can be harmful to many vehicles made before 1996. In response to findings by the FBHVC ([www.fbhvc.co.uk](http://www.fbhvc.co.uk)), Frost has introduced Ethomix, an additive which is said to prevent corrosion in the fuel system & internal engine components, gum & resin build-up and carbon deposits. It also prevents clogged carburettors, injectors, filters & fuel lines. Suitable for both two and four-stroke engines, Z355 Frost Ethomix additive costs £12 for 250ml, which is enough for 250 litres of petrol (about 55 gallons in old money).
