

2007 Atlantic Coast Express Run



Sunday 13th May sees the 10th Atlantic Coast Express Run starting from the Old Oakhampton Railway Station, now owned by the Dartmoor Railway, where light refreshments will be available prior to the start.

The tour will travel via Exeter, Topsham, along the South coast, or as it is known now as the Jurassic Coast, to Bridport before heading inland to finish for a Devonshire Cream Tea at the delightful Fishponds Country House Hotel at Dunkeswell, just north of Honiton.

Some of the roads used will be unclassified, narrow steep hills together with a ford, so hopefully will present you with a flavour of motoring in the 1920s and 30s.
