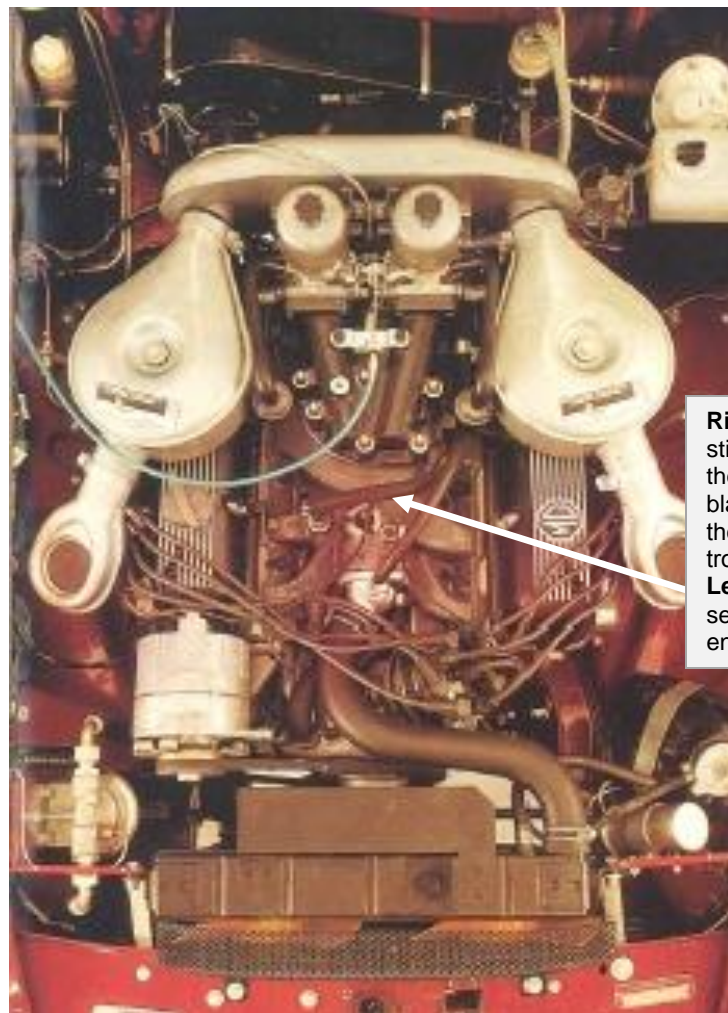
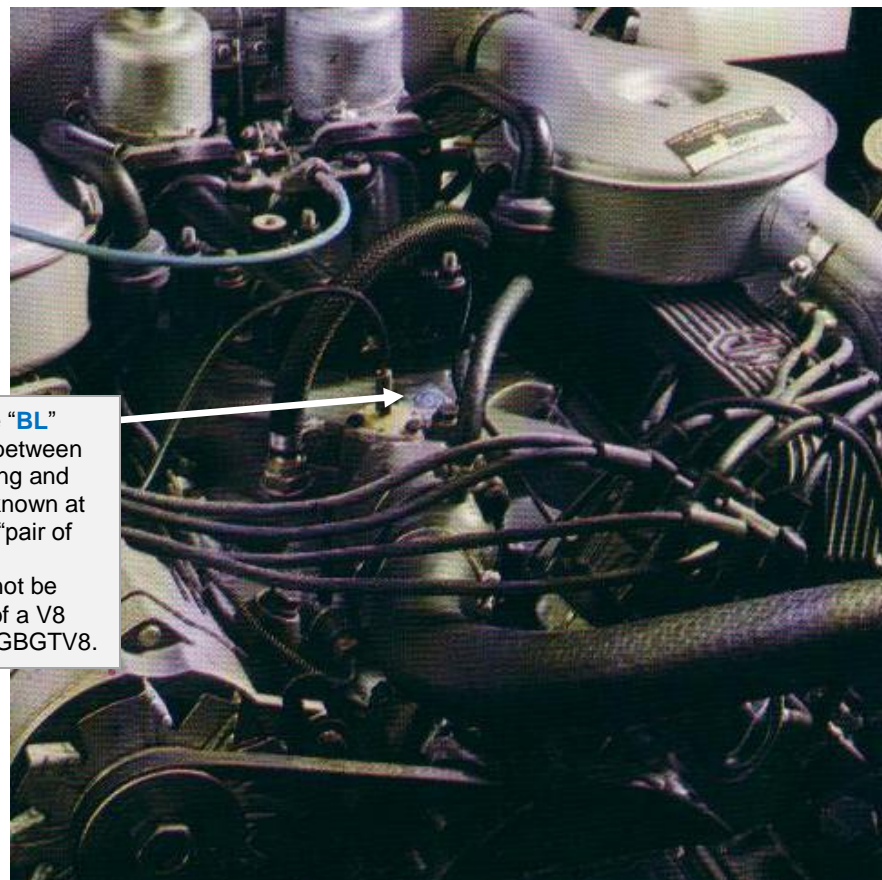


MGBGT V8 Archives – which V8s had a small blue “BL” sticker between the thermostat housing and inlet manifold?



Right: the small blue “BL” sticker can be seen between the thermostat housing and black inlet manifold known at the MG Plant as the “pair of trousers”.
Left: the sticker cannot be seen on the photos of a V8 engine in an early MGBGT V8.

A photo of the V8 engine is included on page 12 of this brochure dated July 1973 for an early chrome bumpered MGBGT V8 (note the cooling fans guard on the radiator and two sets of clips on the air filters) but you can see there is **not** a small blue “BL” sticker.
