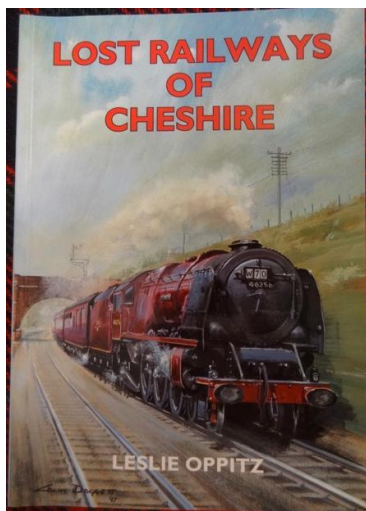
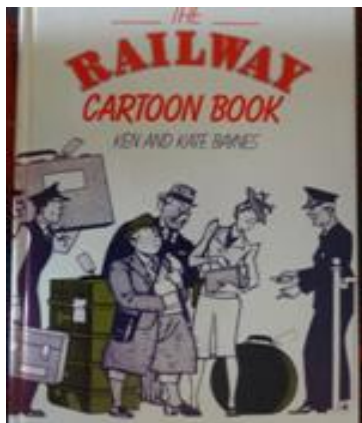


Geoff Allen's books for sale – railway and steam books

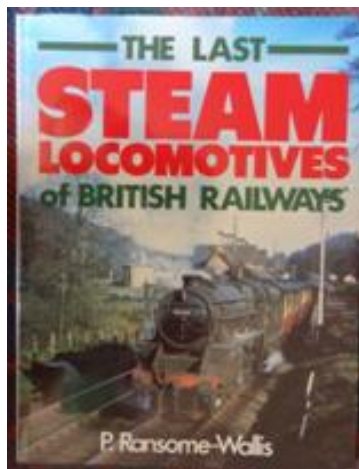

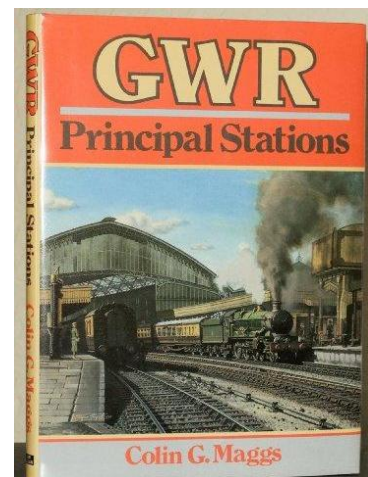
