# V8 Register's 2019 Accounts – V8 Treasurers Report

I would like to give members more details of the figures in the accounts sheets. Please look at your copy of the 2019 accounts sheets. <u>2019 accounts</u>

Looking at the Income and Expenditure account sheet.

### The Books & Publications figure of £2,201.

Books account for £1,552.80 of the income coming from the sale of Barrie's Notes and reprint of The RV8 Story book and Income from Adverts, for the sale of cars via the website, amounted to £647.74 These two items give a total of £2,200.54

### **Expenditure £621**

Purchases of books during the year amounted to £856.00. Adding the opening stock of £56.40 less the closing stock of £285.80 gives the figure of £620.60

### **Profit (loss)**

The income less expenditure (£2,200.54 – £620.60) leaves a figure of £1,579.94

#### **Donations £96**

There were two donations of £10 from members during the year and £75.80 from the V8 Register Technical Day event.

#### Regalia £597

The Sale of Key Rings and Pens via the Club Shop amounted to £22.50. Sales via the V8 Website Factory Records, V8 and RV8 notes and Grille Badges amounted to £574.36 giving a total of £596.86

#### Other Items £178

£178.36 was a refund from WorldPay who over deducted for the 2018 annual fee.

Income £3,080 less expenditure of £696 gave a profit £2,385 before Admin Deductions.

### **Current Assets**

The value of the Stock of Regalia for resale is	£418.00
The value of the Stock of Publications for resale is	£286.00
Owed by the Main Club to the V8 Register is	£12.00
Cash at the Bank is	£6,321.00
This gives the Register a Total Net Assets of	£7,036.00

The income has increased from £1421 in 2018 to £2,385 in 2019 a gain of £964.00.

While the income has increased the expenditure has reduced from £1,660 to £1,300 over the previous year (2018) giving a saving of £360.

The result is an increase in profit of £1,325.00
