

Replacing spacer fixing pads on a number plate

A quick and easy number plate fixing is to use double-sided adhesive pads between the back of the number plate and the front of the metal back plate. They are available as PlateFix sets supplied by Hills Numberplates and readily available from Halfords.

They are available as 1mm and 6mm thick pads and come in packs with three double-sided spacer pads. The 6mm pads enable surface mounting on non-flat surfaces with projections over the mounting area and the 1mm pads can be used with a flat surface.

Clean all wax and debris from both the mounting surface of the back plate and the reverse side of the number plate using a clean cloth. You may need to remove the remains of earlier broken traces

of earlier adhesive pads and then use the multipurpose cleaning wipe that comes with the kit to prepare the adhesive fixing areas on the back plate and the number plate. The cleaning wipe contains Isopropyl Alcohol which helps make clean fixing surfaces.





You apply each of the three spacer pads to the reverse side of the number plate, then remove the protective film from the other face of each pad, locate and finally press the plate in position on the back plate. Apply firm pressure for 10 seconds to ensure the pads bond to the surfaces.
