MGBGTV8 50th Anniversary Lap

Celebrating the launch of the V8 in 1973, there will be 50 MGBGTV8s in a Parade Lap round the Grand Prix Circuit at Silverstone at lunchtime on Saturday 10th June at the MG-Triumph 100 meeting. It's proving very popular with brisk bookings from V8 enthusiasts in the UK and Europe.

Before the weekend at Silverstone

On Wednesday 7th June we have a **visit to Rousham House**, a particularly attractive house NNE of Oxford which has been in the same family for over 500 years. It has exceptional gardens running down to the River Cherwell. With a relaxed drive reaching Rousham by mid-morning, and then a guided tour of the house you can then visit the walled gardens where you can enjoy a picnic lunch. The following day we have an **informal lunch at Sywell Aerodrome**, just NE of Northampton, in the Art Deco aero clubhouse. It's a beautiful period building with views over light aircraft activity on the airfield.

On Saturday morning 19th August we have a **display of MGV8s** on the market place in the centre of Abingdon followed by a **buffet lunch at the Dog House pub** at Frilford to the west of

On Sunday 20th August we have our **major 50th Anniversary event at the BMHIT Motor Museum at Gaydon** with a display of notable MGV8s next to an MGV8 parking area, but the focus of the event will be in two dedicated meeting rooms inside the museum. On arrival V8 members and friends will have refreshments and nearby a second room with several illustrated talks on the MGBGTV8 and RV8 models, together with illustrated reports from members on recent MGV8 restorations.
